WHEREAS, the parties have jointly requested from the Court a proposed schedule,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. **Fact Discovery.** The close of fact discovery shall be **November 29, 2019**.
2. **Expert Witness Discovery.** Expert witness discovery shall be completed by no later than **March 27, 2020**.
 - a. **Initial Expert Witness Reports.** By no later than **December 20, 2019**, the parties shall submit opening expert reports.
 - b. **Responsive Expert Witness Reports (if any).** By no later than **February 3, 2020**, the parties shall submit the reports of expert witnesses whose testimony may be offered to respond to initial expert witnesses.
 - c. **Rebuttal Expert Witness Reports (if any).** By no later than **March 2, 2020**, the parties shall submit the reports of expert witnesses whose testimony may be offered to rebut responsive expert witnesses.
3. **Summary Judgment and Daubert Motions.** Summary judgment motions and motions under *Daubert v. Merrell Dow Pharms., Inc.*, 509 U.S. 579 (1993) shall be filed within


30 days after close of expert discovery, or if no expert reports, **January 3, 2020**. Summary judgment and *Daubert* oppositions shall be filed within 30 days after the filing of the motion. Summary judgment and *Daubert* replies shall be filed within 15 days after filing of the opposition.

4. Case will be trial-ready after the close of discovery unless expert reports are submitted and/or motions for summary judgment are made, in which circumstance the case will be trial-ready upon the completion of expert reports or summary judgment proceedings, as appropriate.
